The Naked Truth About Sin

History Maker's How the Bible Changed Everything Part 1 Genesis 3

January 7, 2018

1. The cause of sin.

(Vs.1) "Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, You must not eat from any tree in the garden?"

"For everything in the world--the cravings of sinful man, the lust of his eyes and the boasting of what he has and does--comes not from the Father but from the world."
1 John 2:16 (NIV)

2. Satan questioned God's Word!

(Vs.1b) "Did God really say, You must not eat from any tree in the garden.."

(Vs.3) "but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.'"

(Vs.4) "You will not surely die," the serpent said to the woman.

3. Satan accused God of withholding His best!

(Vs.5) "For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

4. Eve reasoned in her heart that her actions were right!

(Vs.6) “When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it.”

5. The consequence of sin.

(Vs.7) “Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made coverings for themselves.”

(Vs.8) “Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the LORD God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the LORD God among the trees of the garden.”

(Vs.5) “for God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.”

6. The cure for sin.

(Vs.15) “and I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.”

(Vs.21) The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them.
